- 4:00 Members reviewed the minutes from the September meeting as presented. Heather motioned to approve, Angela seconded, and the minutes were approved, with Billy and Renee abstaining from the vote as they were not in attendance.

- 4:00 Members reviewed the minutes from the August meeting as presented. Heather motioned to approve, Jeromy seconded, and the minutes were approved unanimously.
- 4:15 The DCS Montessori School Performance Framework (SPF) was reviewed by SAC members. Notable improvements were reviewed: Elem ELA scores improved from 57%ile to 76%ile. Elem ELA Growth (SAC Goal) improved form 21%ile to the 44%ile. Elem Math (SAC Goal) scores improved from the 44%ile to the 56%ile. Middle School ELA scores improved from 82%ile to the 89%ile. Middle School Math (SAC Goal) scores improved from the 65%il to the 79%ile.
- 4:30 SAC members discussed whether current goals might be exited due to the current improvements. Elem academic growth still has opportunity for continued growth, but Math is showing solid gains. New goals discussed included examining growth of minority students, and determining teacher opinions on minority students' academic achievement and growth.

- 4:45 SAC members listened to the administration report on the current funding situation which is a deficit due to replacing the main roof. The MLO and Bond was discussed, and Board's consistent support for staff pay. Members also discussed retention of staff data that might be helpful.
- 5:00 The meeting adjourned discussing the plan for Oct. meeting, scheduling last Thursday of each month.

4:05pm Minutes review and approval from prior meeting(s) — Heather motioned to approve the February and March Meeting minutes as presented, Jeromy seconded and they were unanimously approved.

4:06pm Student Survey review —Meghan presented an overview of the Student Survey Data and the general intent of the survey questions; discussed interpretations and changes to consider; committee reviewed feedback from Ms. Maria who disseminates the majority of the Student Survey; also discussed the questions on the UIP goal of reinvigorating the Montessori principles across the DCSM community (eg, choices in work, self-advocating, self-directing, using the materials for most work, confidence in work contract, teamwork or working as a community, etc); discussed making different versions of the survey based on grade levels (Primary, Lower El, Upper El, Middle School); discussed comparison data to prior years surveys and complications with interpretations of new data without prior context. New lunch program's effect on student hunger was discussed as a change to be monitored. Student safety, student teacher perception, and student belonging and friends were also notes of considerable discussion regarding the data, and consideration for future goal setting.

4:06pm Student Survey review and preparation — Jeromy gave a overview and historical overview of how the survey has been used and the general intent of the survey and some of the questions; the group reviewed the current version of the Student Survey; discussed changes to consider; committee discussed turning several questions into scenario questions rather than the current style of some of the questions; also discussed focusing the questions on the UIP goal of reinvigorating the Montessori principles across the DCSM community (eg, choices in work, self-advocating, self-directing, using the materials for most work, confidence in work contract, teamwork or working as a community, etc); discussed making different versions of the survey based on grade levels (Primary, Lower El, Upper El, Middle School); discussed changing some of the responses to emojis; discussed adding demographic question (boy, girl, I don't want to answer); discussed reorganizing the survey set-up so that questions are organized by theme and flow better; Meghan to share existing SEL-focused surveys currently available from other resources

\*\* Discussed adding Primary into the survey (Primary was excluded in the past); Primary's survey could include four questions based on: getting help, relationships with peers & adults at school, work, environment; questions would be read to Primary students and students will fill-in the picture/emoji for their answer; pictures/emojis would be used for responses; using a neutral proctor to read the questions was discussed so Primary students don't feel pressured or nervous about being truthful; discussed adding a "draw a picture of you feel at school"
